

**TOWN OF GREENVILLE
ORDINANCE NO. 2015-WO-050**

Ordinance Concerning the Establishment for Commercial Tap Fee and Commercial Sewer Rates for Greenville Wastewater Treatment Plant for the Town of Greenville, Indiana.

WHEREAS, the Greenville Municipal Water and Sewer Utility Council for the Town of Greenville, Indiana, in the interest complying with the State of Indiana Code. I.C. 8-1.5-3-8 Rates and Charges, has deemed it necessary that the Greenville Water and Sewer Council develop an Ordinance which increases Commercial Tap Fees and rates to reflect increased infrastructure requirements and;

WHEREAS, the Greenville Municipal Water and Sewer Utility Council for the Town of Greenville, Indiana is the entity for fixing and approving charges for the Greenville Water and Sewer Utility pursuant to I.C. 8-1.5-3 et seq. and;

WHEREAS, after due consideration and discussion after receiving an analysis of current charges and at the monthly meeting held on September 14, 2015 and it was agreed that Commercial Tap Fee and Rates be amended according to appendix “A” attached and;

WHEREAS, Notice of the Public Hearing was published in the New Albany Tribune on October 21, 2015 and;

WHEREAS, the Notice of the Public Hearing was mailed to all Greenville Water and Sewer Utility Customers by L&D Mail Masters Inc. of New Albany, IN on _____, and;

WHEREAS, Notice of the Public Hearing and Proposed Ordinance 2015-WO-050 was posted on the Town of Greenville Website (www.visitgreenvillein.com) and the Greenville Town Hall and Greenville Municipal Water and Sewer Utility Offices on October 20, 2015 and;

Whereas, the need to prevent sewer line blockage, Greenville Municipal Water and Sewer Utility is requiring all commercial customers and non-single family dwelling homes to have a 1,000 gallon grease trap installed. The traps must be installed according to all plumbing codes and have a 90% removal rate of FOGS (Fats, Oils and greases). Each trap shall be inspected and cleaned every 12 months.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GREENVILLE MUNICIPAL WATER AND SEWER COUNCIL FOR THE TOWN OF GREENVILLE, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:

1. In accordance with I.C. 8-1-5.3-8.1, and after the introduction of this Ordinance at the Public Hearing on November 9th, 2015 at which customers of the Greenville Municipal Water and Sewer Utility, owners of property served or to be served by the Greenville Municipal Water and Sewer Utility, and other interested persons may be heard concerning the proposed commercial tap fee and rates set forth herein. Notice of the hearing shall be published in accordance with I.C. 5-3-1 et seq and mailed in accordance with I.C. 8-1.5-3.8.1. After the hearing of the Greenville Municipal Water and Sewer Utility Council may at it next schedule Monthly meeting adopt this Ordinance, either as originally introduced or as modified. A copy of the schedule of commercial tap fee and rates adopted herein shall be kept on file and available for public inspection at the offices of the Greenville Municipal Water and Sewer Utility and the Greenville Municipal Water and Sewer Utility Clerk/Treasurer Office.
2. This Ordinance shall be effective on the 1st day of the Month after adoption and being published in the New Albany Tribune in accordance with I.C. 5-3-1 through I.C. 5-3-1-9 unless delayed in accordance with I.C. 8-1.5-3-8.2 which allows owners of property connected or to be connected to and served by the Greenville Municipal Water and Sewer Utility to file a written petition objecting to the charges set forth herein so long as 1) the petition contains the names and addresses of the petitioners; 2) the petitioners attended the Public Hearing provided under I.C. 8-1.5-3-8-1; 3) written petition is filed with the Greenville Water and Sewer Utility Council within five (5) days after this Ordinance is adopted pursuant to I.C. 8-1.5-3-8.2; The signature of petitioners must appear on Public Hearing Sign-in Sheet, 4) the written petition states specifically the ground or grounds of objection.

Appendix A – Ordinance 2015-wo-050
Commercial Tap Rate and Monthly Charges.

Current Residential Charge is: \$4,000 Tap, \$65/Month Flat Rate

Commercial Tap Charge: \$6,000 for ¾" meter
\$8,000 for 1" meter
\$10,000 for 2' meter

Commercial Rate \$65 Flat + \$3.00 Per 1,000 Gallons
Example Rates:

10,000 Gallons would equal \$95.00

20,000 Gallons would equal \$125.00

30,000 Gallons would equal \$195.00

50,000 Gallons would equal \$215.00

100,000 Gallons would equal \$365.00
