

MINUTES OF GREENVILLE TOWN COUNCIL MONTHLY MEETING, February 11, 1992

The regular monthly meeting of the Council was called to order by President Ron Lamb at 8:00 p.m. All Councilmembers were present as was the Clerk of the Council. Also attending was Harry Shields, Tim Hunt [SEICO], Gary Getrost, Janice Gibson, and Billy Burkhart.

The Council approved Minutes of the January meeting, claims for the Town/Utility, Bond and payment thereof of the Clerk Treasurer and Janice Gibson.

Harry Shields informed the Council his presence at the meeting was to talk to person (s) contemplating placing a radio tower on the old quarry property. Ron Lamb stated the town does not have any control of the placing of the tower; further Ron stated he did not believe the radio company would be represented at this meeting.
