Special Meeting – February 23, 2009

The Council met for a special meeting at 7:00 pm to discuss the performance pertaining to the snow removal contract and the snow fall in January 2009. All council members were present however no one for the Silling Company appeared. President Richardson requested a council member contact attorney Fox about the notification.

Special Meeting - March 9, 2009

President Talbotte Richardson called the special meeting to order at the Greenville Town Hall at 6:30 PM. Councilpersons present were Hanzel Barclay, Randal Holmes, Bob Wright, Patti Hayes, President Talbotte Richardson, Clerk Jack Travillian, Attorney Dick Fox and concerned citizens.

The Council met for a special meeting to discuss the performance pertaining to the snow removal charges for the snow fall in January 2009

Jason Silling representing Silling Company appeared before the council to answer questions. The council requested clarification about the volume of salt use and time spent on the January billing. The first question was why was salt pick up in New Albany? The pickups in New Albany were sometimes necessary because the Greenville branch was not open. Also it was closer to pickup there than to drive back to his shop. Why was so much salt used? Response was the salt was not overused, the spreaders are calibrated. Why were the alleys not scraped? Ice can not be scraped. Why so much time? Response I did the scraping myself (Jason presented the council with a time sheet). On the salt uses, why was the first pickup 10 days before the snow fall? The first load was taken to my shop and put up for storage. The council asked about the time "Why so long"? Mr. Silling gave a description of the route he took and explained that he had done most of Wind Dance Subdivision. President Richardson stated that there is a misunderstanding as to where the town's corporate limits are in Wind Dance Subdivision. The council gave instruction that only stage one should be done. Councilman Barclay will go with Mr. Silling sometime next week. The council voted to pay the invoices.
