MINUTES OF TOWN COUNCIL MEETING

The regular monthly meeting of the Greenville Town Council was called to order by President Ron Lamb. All Council Members were present. Also attending were Talbott Richardson, Bob Isgrigg, Gary Getrost, David Owens, Sherri Jecker, Mr. and Mrs. Jerry Burkhart, and several students from a Government class at Floyd Central High School.

Minutes of the February meeting were approved. Claims for the Town/Utility were approved.

Gary Getrost made a mention of a water tower painting company which has recently moved into Greenville. The owner approached Gary on the possibility of painting the Greenville Tower. Gary is to look up information as to how long it has been and if repainting is necessary.

Computer Mapping was brought up and discussed for a short time. The board wants to set up an appointment with Computer Resources Corp. to have a demonstration prior to the next Town Board Meeting.


Butch Richardson expressed a concern to Ron Lamb over the creek running beside his house. The creek has filled up with gravel and dirt and is causing problems with the creek rising too high.

David Owen, Manager of Harrison County Bank, (Greenville Branch) touched on a proposal made by President Bush concerning small banks. Mr. Owens stated that under this proposal, all small banks would become extinct. Mr. Owens also encouraged anyone concerned with this matter to write their State Representatives.


Jerry Burkhart inquired about the possibility of closing an alley which divides his property on East 5th and US 150. After little discussion it was decided not to close it.

No further business coming before the council, Harold Hall motioned for adjournment, seconded by Bob Williams.
