Minutes of Greenville Town Council Meeting November 09th, 2009

Council President Talbotte Richardson called the regular monthly meeting to order. Other Councilpersons present were Bob Wright, Patti Hayes, James Pearce and Randal Johnes, along with Clerk Jack Travillian. Also attending the meeting were Water Utility Superintendent Gary Getrost, town attorney Rick Fox, and other concerned citizens. Chaplain Mark Avery opened the meeting with a prayer, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes: Council President Richardson made a motion and Councilman Johnes seconded to accept the October 12th monthly minutes as revised by Councilman Johnes. Motion passed 5-0. Motion was made by Council President Richardson and seconded by Councilman Johnes to approve the minutes for the Public Hearings on the Heritage Springs Annexation held October 13th and 19th as recorded by Councilman Johnes due to the absence of Clerk Travillian. The council voted to approve 5-0.

Councilman Johnes read the following confirming Resolution made in the October 12th, 2009 Monthly Meeting: **Resolution 2009-R-075**; CONFIRMING RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE BUILDING VARIANCE GRANTED TO MATT WOODS OF 9325 ARTHUR COFFMAN ROAD LOCATED WITHIN THE COPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF GREENVILLE, INDIANA.

Marshal's Report:

Marshal Moore reported that the speed limit on Highway 150 was lowered to 35 MPH on October 13th. Officers have been issuing warnings and have had 34 traffic stops for speeding. There were 9 parking violations citations issued, 7 domestic violence runs, 5 runs to back up Floyd County officers, and 1 armed robbery. Marshal Moore requested a board member contact the county about posting speed limit signs on Schuler Road. Councilman Johnes will follow up.

The armed robbery occurred at the Mini-mart on a Saturday afternoon. The store has a video recording which has been viewed by the Greenville Marshal's Department and Detective Joel White who was assigned by the Floyd County Sheriff's Department. The day of the crime all local area vacant homes were searched.

Sellersburg Police Department has started a Reserve Officers Training Program which Steven Schmidt is attending. Marshal Moore is excited about this program and the possibility of basic training for reserve officers.

Water Business:

Council President Richardson requested that Councilman Johnes read the following Resolution.

Councilman Johnes stated that all the Council Members had been contacted to receive approval of repair of the Water Utility Storage Tank in Galena prior to this meeting. The Council Members agreed to have the tank repaired because it had developed a leak and because of the emergency situation Water Utility Superintendent Gary Getrost had been given permission for inspection and repair of the tank and this resolution is to confirm the decision for the Water Utility Records.

Resolution 2009-R-074 RESOLUTION CONFIRMING VERBAL AUTHORITY GIVEN WATER UTILITY SUPERINTENDENT TO INSPECT, REPORT AND REPAIR 60,000 GALLON WATER UTILITY STORAGE TANK LOCATED IN GALENA, INDIANA OWNED BY THE TOWN OF GREENVILLE, INDIANA WATER UTILITY DUE TO AN EMERGENCY SITUTATION; Resolution was read. Motion was made by Councilman Johnes and seconded by Councilwoman Hayes to accept the resolution as read. Resolution passed 5-0.

Accidental Life Insurance: Water Utility personnel policy calls for each employee to have an Accidental Life Insurance Policy equal to an employee's yearly salary. Water Utility Clerk Stone has called about current policies and was told that the increments of upgrade are in \$25,000 with the current Insurance Company providing this coverage. Councilman Johnes instructed Clerk Travillian to contact some additional insurance companies about \$10,000 increment policies. Clerk Travillian is to have this information for the December Monthly Meeting. The Council will decide at that meeting either to change Insurance Companies or the Water Utility Personnel Manual.

Superintendent Getrost submitted monthly adjustments to the council. The board approved the adjustments for the bills (5-0).

Pumping station in Galena: Superintendent Getrost has been working with Indiana American Water that has become very aggressive about the connection. There has been approval by Duke Energy for the easement and Floyd County has approved the plan. Superintendent Getrost is predicting a mid December start on the project.

Floyds Knobs Water Utility has passed an increase of 21 cents per 1,000 gallons along to the Greenville Water Utility. This rate increase will be reflective in the December billing to the Greenville Water Utility. Superintendent Getrost reported that Indiana American Water is seeking a 38% increase which will be decided at the Indiana Regulatory Commission at the April 28, 2010 meeting. The recommendation of the Water Utility Accountant to Superintendent Getrost is to wait until the next round of rate increases have taken affect and pass one increase to our customers.

The utility's water towers inspection: Superintendent Getrost is awaiting the Dixon report from the completed inspections of the two water tanks.

Service Charges: Superintendent Getrost made the council aware of a problem with extra readings requested by some customers. Some of the customers are having several return readings. Getrost requested the council research possibility of creating a fee for additional readings. The rate suggested was around \$35 per visit. Councilman Johnes will work with Town Attorney Fox and Superintendent Getrost to develop a Rate Increase Ordinance to address the situation.

Superintendent Getrost has requested that all water utility employees track the amount of hours spent on Town business for reimbursement from town budget. Councilman Johnes will develop a time sheet to be used by the Water Utility Employees and e-mail it to Clerk Stone. These time sheets are to be submitted once a month to the Greenville Town Clerk for reimbursement to the Greenville Water Utility.

Superintendent Getrost requested a special meeting for the annual review of Water Utility Employees Performance Reviews. An Executive Session shall be set up for 6:00 pm on December 14th, 2009 prior to the regular Monthly Meeting.

Financial:

Review/Approval Checks and Expenditures: Clerk Travillian presented the forms for the checks written from the utility and the town.

Committee Reports:

Councilman Wright/Emergency Services:

Councilman Wright reported that the emergency generators have been purchased by the Water Utility and waiting reimbursement. The generators are stored in the utility garage. Councilman Wright has applied to be on the county council agenda for January 2010 to request financial aid with annual public safety budget. Councilman Wright will be requesting increasing the amount to \$25,000.

The Marshal's Department has requested new coats be purchased. The council had already approved that purchase in a previous meeting.

Councilman Pearce/Streets and Roads:

Council President Richardson requested that Councilman Johnes read the revised resolution concerning Ice and Snow Removal Contractors. It had come to the attention of Councilman Wright that if an individual was bidding for the Ice and Snow Removal they would not be required to provide Workman Compensation Insurance in accordance with Indiana State Codes.

Resolution 2009-R-076 RESOLUTION CONCERNING REPEAL OF VOTE ON SNOW REMOVAL CONTRACTOR 12-08-2008 AND ESTABLISHING A BIDDERS LIST FOR SNOW REMOVAL FOR THE TOWN OF GREENVILLE, INDIANA: Resolution was read and discussed. Motion was made by Councilman Johnes and seconded by Council President Richardson to accept the resolution as read. Resolution passed 5-0.

The three snow removal bids that were received by the council were opened. A Verbal Resolution was made by Councilman Johnes and seconded by Council President Richardson to accept all three bids. They shall be listed in accordance with their bid amounts. The lowest bid was from Clapp LLC for \$79 per hour. The other two bids were the same amount at \$100 per hour from Wright Construction and Tim Smith. The order contacting shall be Clapp, and if unavailable, then Wright Construction due to being located in the Town, followed by Tim Smith if no others are available. Resolution passed as stated 5-0.

Councilman Johnes/Public Relations and Property Cleanup:

Councilman Johnes has sent a certified letter and received a return receipt from the Waggoners concerning the Town's decision about the drainage issue concerning the garage off the alley between West 1st Street and West 2nd Street.

Councilman Johnes announced the drainage issue off of Hanzel Barclay Drive with Mr. and Mrs. Seilers and Mrs. Miller has been resolved.

2009 Citizen of the Year Award: A Verbal Resolution was made by Councilman Johnes and seconded by Council President Richardson for the nomination of Chester "Butch" Richardson as recipient of the 'Citizen of the Year Award' for 2009 for the work he did on the Storm Sewer issues with INDOT in 2008 and 2009. The motion passed 5-0.

A Verbal Resolution was made by Councilman Johnes and seconded President Richardson to declare the old computer from the clerk's office as salvage. Resolution passed 4-0 with Councilwoman Hayes abstaining.

Annexation of Heritage Springs: Councilman Johnes reminded the Council that the next meeting will be held on November 24th for the annexation of Heritage Springs at 7:00 PM at the Town Hall. He reminded Clerk Travillian that a letter of annexation notification must be sent to the Greenville Township Volunteer Fire Department and the New Albany Tribune. He also stated that the publishing in the Tribune should be on the 25th. He noted that the Ordinance must be published in the Tribune no later than November 30th. He also noted that various agencies including the Floyd County Recorder's office must be notified and a certified copy of the ordinance be given to them by March 10, 2010.

The Council will be holding a special meeting on January 18, 2010 for discussion and review of Building Codes for the Town of Greenville to be enforced by the Floyd County Planning Commission in accordance with the inter-local agreement with Floyd County.

Water Utility Expansion: Councilman Johnes requested the council give consideration to the expansion at an estimated cost of \$90,000 to \$120,000 if we sub-contract the work ourselves. Council agreed 4-1 for Councilman Johnes to proceed with plans and specifications to obtain cost estimates for the expansion.

No further business coming before the Council the meeting was adjourned.
