Financial Reports were presented to the board.





ORDINANCE NO. 1983-01

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Greenville, Floyd County, Indiana under the statues and codes of the State of Indiana hereby sets salaries for elected officials of the Town of Greenville to take effect January 1, 1984 and run through December 31, 1987.

BE IT ORDAINED, that salaries listed below shall be paid from different funds, those funds being set apart in this ordinance as noted below.

The salary of the President of the Town Board shall be fixed at \$800.00 per year.

The sum of \$400.00 shall be paid from General Fund of the Town of Greenville and the sum of \$400.00 shall be paid from the funds of the Greenville Water Utility.


The salary of the Town Board Members shall be fixed at \$600.00 per year.

The sum of \$300.00 shall be paid from the General Fund of the Town of Greenville and the sum of \$300.00 shall be paid from the funds of the Greenville Water Utility.


The salary of the Clerk/Treasurer shall be fixed at \$1,500.00 per year.

The sum of \$700.00 shall be paid from the General Fund of the Town of Greenville and the sum of \$800.00 shall be paid from the Greenville Water Utility.





The purpose of the meeting was to designate Public Depositories for the period beginning February 1983 and ending February 1985, the third Monday of each Year.


Therefore the Town of Greenville Board of Trustees adopted the attached resolution to Public Depositories for the 21 st day of February 1983.

PROPOSAL AND AGREEMENT TO
RECEIVE PUBLIC FUNDS ON DEPOSIT

To the Board of Finance of Floyd County, Indiana

Undersigned hereby proposes to, and upon acceptance hereof, agrees to become and act as a depository for public funds of the municipal corporations herein named for the biennial period beginning on the third Monday in February, 1983, and ending on the third Monday in February, 1985, to safely keep, account for, pay over and deliver said funds, or any part thereof when lawfully demanded, and to perform the duties and obligations which are imposed upon depositories of public funds by the laws of the State of Indiana, including those imposed by The Depository Act of 1937.

The principal office and place of business of undersigned is at 400 State Street in New Albany Township, Floyd County, State of Indiana. The total resources of undersigned as of the date of the called report nearest the date of this proposal, excluding from said total resources an amount equal to all public funds on deposit with undersigned as of said date, is \$108,964,938.
