
The board agreed that Mr. Gibson should pursue his proposal of improvements to the gym. In addition the possibility of borrowing necessary capital that is available should also be checked into.

The board agreed that if necessary financing can be obtained the Town of Greenville propose to the Floyd County School Board that a transfer be me made to the town the gym.

2. The board agreed to charge a fee of \$.50 per ^{1000 gals,} ~~hundred~~ on excess water usage by customers due to faulty lines.
