MINUTES OF TOWN COUNCIL MEETING

The regular monthly meeting of the Greenville Town Council was called to order by President Ron Lamb. All Councilmembers were present; also the Clerk Treasurer. Others in attendance were Bob Isgrigg, Gary Getrost, David Owens, Talbott Richardson, and Mike Receiver.

Minutes of the March meeting was approved as read. Claims for the town and utility were approved by the Council.

The Clerk Treasurers' report indicate bank balances appear to be correct.

The Council appointed Janice Gibson as the Town representative on the River Hills Board.

Bob Isgrigg informed the Council he will have additional charges for final work done on the dam project. Ron Lamb stated the Council is reviewing names of property appraisers to be used by the town for the dam improvement.

Gary Getrost apprised the Council of the insurance company representative performing an inspection of the lake area. Gary stated the representative would make recommendations based on his findings.


