

GREENVILLE TOWN BOARD  
APRIL 13, 1982

The regular monthly meeting of the Greenville Town Board was opened by President Jack Sprigler. All board members were present in addition to G. Getrost, J. Gibson, T. Richardson, M. Powell, M. Mason and many interested Citizens.

Minutes of the previous meeting were approved by the Board. Financial statements were presented to the Board.

A motion was made by H.L. Spears and seconded by Ronald Lamb to pay G. Getrost twenty cents per mile for the use of his personal truck for Water Utility work this past month.

Robert Evans, Jean Miller and Una Hartfield were appointed by the board, as a committee to establish boundary lines for the Wards of the Town.

The motion by Ron Lamb and seconded by H.L. Spears, stated that the town would pay the county Fifty Dollars for each load of cinders delivered to Greenville.

Mr. Evans and Mr. Law representing the Greenville Church and Greenville Masonic Lodge registered a complaint about the house between the the Christian Church and Lodge Hall. A motion was made by H.L. Spears and seconded by Ron Lamb to develop a Razing Ordinance, Max Mason will also contact Pat Hoagland from Floyd County Planning Commission to see what can be done.

Mr. Mason was directed by the board to develop a Dressing Code to fit the needs of Greenville, a new Mobile Home Ordinance, an Ordinance on Junk and an Ordinance on Disabled Vehicles.
