Minutes of Greenville Town Council Meeting May 09^{th,} 2011

Council President Talbotte Richardson called the regular monthly meeting to order. Other Councilpersons present were Bob Wright, James Pearce, Patti Hayes, and Randal Johnes, along with Clerk Jack Travillian. Also attending the meeting were Water Utility Superintendent Getrost, and other concerned citizens. The meeting was opened with a prayer by Pastor Avery, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes: The amended minutes for April 11th meeting were discussed. Motion made by President Richardson and seconded by Councilman Johnes to accept the minutes as amended. Motion passed 5-0.

Marshal Report:

Marshal Moore noted tickets and criminal reports are down. Marshal Moore has been elected to Vice President of the Marshal's Association. In order to save on gasoline the town officers will be patrolling in two man units.

Councilwoman Hayes reported that she had received information that the county will not be providing the \$20,000 from the River Boat Funds as expected for Marshal Department salaries. The Floyd County auditor's office has informed Councilwoman Hayes that the funding for Riverboat has been changed and Greenville will now receive a percentage of what is collected quarterly. Clerk Travillian noted that by information received it appears that the town will be lowered from receiving \$23,500 to about \$14,000 for annual payments.

Councilman Johnes shall prepare an Ordinance for transfer of funds from the LRS Account to the General Fund Marshal Payroll Account for the June Monthly Meeting to compensate for the loss of funding from the county.

Marshal Moore request \$290 for ammunition and \$180 for annual dues for annual training. Councilman Johnes made a motion and Councilwoman Hayes seconded to pay the amounts from the General Fund – Equipment Account. Motion passed 5-0.

Water Business:

Superintendent Getrost submitted monthly adjustments to the council. The board approved the adjustments for the bills without objection.

Greenville Water Utility received a notice from Floyds Knobs Water Utility that rates will be increased by 7 cents per 1,000 gallons. Superintendent Getrost noted that this was a minimal increase and recommended that rates stay at current levels until a pass through can be dealt with at a later time. The council agreed 5-0.

Superintendent Getrost informed the council that there has been a complaint about water/soil pollution at a property adjacent to the former water utility reservoir on Voyles Road. Superintendent Getrost has given a file to the town attorney for reviewing.

Councilman Johnes reported Mr. Lanz told him that the Indiana Department of Environmental Management has reported that the Heritage Springs sewage treatment plant is expandable to meet the town's needs. Mr. Lanz will present his report to the council at the June Monthly Meeting. Councilman Johnes will prepare an Ordinance to proceed with step II of the process.

The Water Utility received no bids on the 2003 Chevrolet S10 pickup truck. Councilman Johnes suggested perhaps a better use for the truck would be to use it as an animal control vehicle. Councilman Wright offered to list the truck on Craig's List. The council agreed on a price at \$4,500.

Clerk Travillian presented the council a proposal from ISU Insurance to renew the health insurance with Humana. The current policy will have a 22% increase or there is an additional policy with a raise in deductable from the current level of \$1,000 to a level of \$2,500 per calendar year at about the current rate. There will be a special meeting to make a decision on May 23, 2011 at 7:00 PM.

Financial:

Review/Approval Checks and Expenditures: Clerk Travillian presented the forms for the checks written from the utility and the town.

Streets and Roads:

Councilman Wright reported that the street repairs have been completed with some additional pot holes being done without additional charges by Striegel Paving.

Special Projects:

Councilman Johnes reported the Ordinance regulating pornography should be ready for discussion/consideration at next month's meeting.

The meeting with New Albany/Floyd County Animal Control about the January 12, 2005 interlocal cooperation government agreement was discussed and they will be providing the agreed services. Marshal Moore stated that his office has been receiving calls about animal control and requested that the New Albany/Floyd County Animal Shelter be reminded of their responsibilities. The New Albany/Floyd County Animal Shelter has requested that the town adopt the Floyd County Animal Control Ordinance. The council discussed the proposal and decided there was virtually no benefit from adopting it.

Attorney Fox:

Attorney Fox reminded the council that there are several issues that will need to be resolved with purchasing a sewage treatment plant. Issues include bond rates, hookup costs, and possible grant money.

No further business coming before the Council the meeting was adjourned.

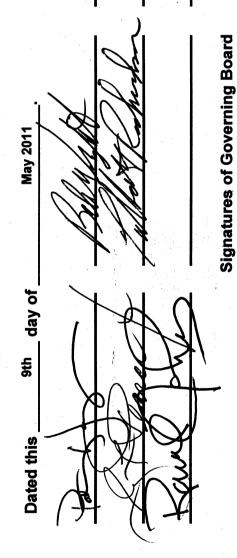

This letter is in response to your March 9, 2011 request for preliminary effluent limitations for a proposed upgrade of the Heritage Springs Wastewater Treatment Plant. As indicated in your request, the average design flow of the WWTP will be increased from 0.1 MGD to 0.2 MGD, 0.4 MGD or 0.6 MGD. The treatment type would continue to be bio-mechanical. The facility would continue to discharge via the existing outfall location to Jersey Park Creek. The $Q_{7.10}$ low-flow of the receiving stream at the point of discharge is considered to be zero cfs.

A Wasteload Allocation Analysis (WLA001834) was performed by this Office's staff on April 5, 2011 for the proposed facility upgrade. The following effluent limits are appropriate for the aforementioned bio-mechanical wastewater treatment plant with an average design flow of 0.2 MGD, 0.4 MGD or 0.6 MGD with continuous discharge to Jersey Park Creek:

The wasteload allocation analysis calculated a summer ammonia-nitrogen limit of 1.6 mg/l as a monthly average (2.4 mg/l as a weekly average) and a winter ammonia-nitrogen limit of 3.2 mg/l as a monthly average (4.8 mg/l as a weekly average). If the permittee is willing to accept the ammonia-nitrogen limitations in Table 1 (which are the permittee's existing NPDES permit limitations), then the design of the upgrade may proceed without having to submit an antibacksliding exception request. If the permittee chooses to pursue the less stringent ammonia-nitrogen limits mentioned above, then the permittee would need to submit an antibacksliding exception request that satisfies the antibacksliding provisions contained in 327 IAC 5-2-10(11). This would be a prerequisite to application for a construction permit.

For the above-referenced discharge scenario, the following requirements will apply: Flow must be measured. The mass limits for CBOD₅, NH₃-N, and TSS are calculated by multiplying the average design flow (in MGD) by the corresponding concentration value and by 8.345. Summer effluent limits apply from May 1 through November 30 of each year. Winter effluent limits apply December 1 through April 30 of each year.

If chlorination is utilized as the method of disinfection, the effluent must then be dechlorinated to the lowest detectable level. The compliance value is set equivalent to the Limit of Quantitation (LOQ) for chlorine (0.06 mg/l). The effluent limitations for *E. coli* are 125 count/100 mls as a monthly average calculated as a geometric mean and 235 count/100 mls as a daily maximum.

The water quality-based limits set forth in this letter are based on the Indiana water quality standards in effect at this time and may not be the final limits once an NPDES permit modification is issued. If the water quality standards are modified by the Water Pollution Control Board and new water quality standards become effective prior to the date the NPDES permit for the facility is actually modified, then IDEM is required by law to issue the modified NPDES permit with limits based on the new standards.

In addition, you may need to complete an antidegradation demonstration before IDEM can issue the NPDES permit for this facility. This demonstration could alter (and possibly make more stringent) the limits that are finally established in the NPDES permit.

Also, note that these preliminary effluent limitations are based upon a wasteload allocation analysis which only evaluated the typical conventional pollutants. Since the wastestream has not been fully characterized, IDEM reserves the right to establish effluent limitations for additional pollutant parameters as deemed necessary. This letter does not guarantee the approval of any permits.

If you have any questions regarding design requirements of the construction permit, please contact Mr. Don Worley at 317/232-5579. The NPDES permit modification will not be issued to reflect the upgrade until the construction permit is finalized. At a minimum, the modification request should be submitted at least 180 days prior to completion of the upgrade activities. Please be advised that the modification request must be accompanied by a \$50.00 fee in accordance with IC 13-18-20-12.

Dear Jonathan,

It was a pleasure meeting with you and your clients the other day. Pursuant to our discussion, it is my understanding that the New Albany Floyd County Animal Control and Shelter will provide Article 5 services to the Town of Greenville. The Town of Greenville understands and agrees that the New Albany Floyd County Animal Control and Shelter has jurisdiction over Article 5 services. Further, the Town of Greenville will not interfere with the New Albany Floyd County Animal Control and Shelter during such time that the animal shelter is providing Article 5 services to the residents of the Town of Greenville. This will be true regardless of whether the notification came in from a Board member, a resident of the Town of Greenville, or event if the animal control employee observes an Article 5 issue while in the corporate limits in the Town of Greenville. The Town of Greenville understands that all of the rules and regulations of the New Albany Floyd County Animal Control and Shelter associated with Article 5 services have priority and control with regards to the Town of Greenville Ordinance No. 2010-T-056. On behalf of the Town of Greenville, I appreciate the New Albany Floyd County Animal Control and Shelter providing Article 5 services to the Town of Greenville, Lastly, as we discussed, I will be speaking with the Town of Greenville Board members at our next meeting about the possibility of adopting the Floyd County Animal Control Ordinance. I will keep you updated with respect to the same.

On April 21, 2011 we receive a letter from Floyds Knobs Water Co. (FKWC) notifying us of an increase which was passed on to FKWC from their supplier Ramsey Water Co. after the first of the year (2011). It was determined by the FKWC Board of Directors that it was necessary to pass this increase on to its water customers in order to continue operating in the black.

This increase will be 7 cents per 1000 gallons, making the new rate \$3.27 per 1000 gallons. The new price will be applied to the water purchased in the May 2011 billing cycle.

The effects of this increase to Greenville Water will amount to approximately \$140.00 per month, \$1680.00 per year (based on 2,000,000 gallons per month).

I personally consider this to be minimal, although it is \$1680.00 less revenue per year that this utility will take in.

The good news is that after researching the effects of this increase I discovered that when our increase was calculated, Edwardsville water was estimated to increase to \$1.72 per 1000 gallons and the monthly service charge was to increase to \$7940.92. We just recently received our notice of increase from Edwardsville Water Co. and it states that our price per 1000 gallons is \$1.71 and the monthly charge is \$7865.00. This calculates a positive in the utility's favor of \$100.00 per month, (\$1200.00 per year) on the cost per 1000 gallons (based on 10,000,000

gallons per month). It also calculates a positive in the utility's favor of \$75.92 per month, (\$911.00 per year) on the monthly service charge. This calculates a total positive in the utility's favor of \$2111.00 per year on Edwardsville Water's over estimation which will more than offset the \$1680.00 per year increase from FKWC.

Do to the costs associated with doing a pass through to recover this 7 cents per 1000 gallons increase, I am recommending to the Council that we do nothing at this time but at the time of our next pass through or increase we go back and pick up this 7 cents per 1000 gallons increase.
