Mr. Mason submitted two Ordinances for Board approval. The board will have to adopt the Ordinances then we will publish it and have a hearing.

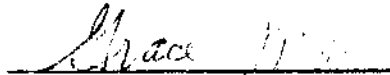
Mr Hoagland of Floyd County Planning & Zoning Commission indicated that his group would not take charge in Greenville but would work with our town to find our needs and help us adopt Ordinances to fit the need. There will be no cost to the town because of the Building Permit cost, they should be sufficient to take care of any expenses. Mr. Hoagland suggested a five day waiting period between applying for a permit and getting one. Mr. Mason stated that Greenville needs a long range Master Plan.

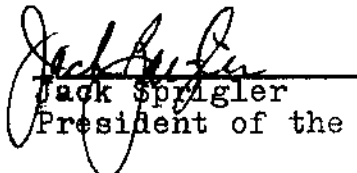
