MINUTES OF GREENVILLE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING, June 9, 1998.

The regular monthly meeting of the Greenville Town Council was called to order immediately following the Public Hearing for the Water Utility Rate Increase, with Council Members Ray Gibson and Mike Receveur in attendance. Council Member Gerry Burkhart was absent. Also attending was those persons that decided to stay for the meeting after the public hearing.

Minutes of the May 12, 1998 was read. On motion by Mike Receveur and seconded by Ray Gibson, the minutes were approved, with changes, by a vote of 3-0.

Minutes of the Water Utility meeting of May 21, 1998 was read. On motion by Ray Gibson, seconded by Mike Receveur, the minutes were approved by a vote of 3-0.

Jim Ragins stated he was back in six (6) months for the Council to consider and extension for trailer use for his used car lot. Miller stated he needs to have a permanent structure that conforms to the Town ordinances. The Council (3-0) extended his present trailer use for six (6) months longer to allow him the necessary to build or place a trailer on the lot (US150) that conforms to Town Ordinances.

The Council (3-0) approved Transfer Ordinance 1998-T-02 in the amount of \$324.00.

Gary Getrost presented the Council with new rates for Alternative Health. Ray motioned, seconded by Mike to approve the new contract with Alternative Health. Motion carried (3-0).


The Council, by a vote of 3-0 approved a water bill adjustment for Dan Page in the amount of \$96.63.

The Council voted 3-0 to cancel the June Water Utility meeting.

The Council approved(3-0) claims for the Town/Utility.

No further business coming before the Council the meeting was adjourned at approximately 8:45 p.m.
