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Minutes of Greenville Town Council Meeting July 8th, 2013

Council President Talbotte Richardson called the regular monthly meeting to order. Other Councilpersons present were Bob Wright, Patti Hayes, and Greg Redden, along with Clerk Jack Travillian. Also attending the meeting were Town Manager Randal Johnes, Town Marshal Bill Burkhart, Water Superintendent Gary Getrost and several concerned citizens. The meeting was opened with a prayer from Pastor Sparks, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes: The minutes for June 10th regular meeting was discussed. Motion was made by President Richardson and seconded by Councilman Redden to accept the proposed minutes. Motion passed 4-0.

Marshal Report:

Marshal Burkhart presented the council members with the monthly report. The department is still working on getting a COPS grant in order to attract new younger officer with proper funding. COPS have requested additional information. The Marshal's Department would like to thank Floyd County Council and Floyd County Sheriff Mills for the upgrade of a 2010 Ford Crown Vic to replace the 1996 Jeep Cherokee. This will help with the officer's safety, which is the primary goal.

The Marshal's Department is investigating some criminal mischievous activities; it appears to be children involved. Marshal Burkhart would like to also thank the Greenville Volunteer Fire Department for helping to revive his father after an illness recently, without their quick response he may not have survived.

Financial: Review/Approval Checks and Expenditures: Clerk Travillian presented the forms for the checks written from the utility and the town. The checks were approved without objections. Clerk Travillian advised the council about an overpayment received from the Floyd County Auditor's office that was around \$34,000. Travillian has been in contact with the Auditor and was told it had been caused by a computer software issue.

Clerk Travillian advised the council on a recent meeting with Mike Whalen, the town's insurance representative. It was suggested to increase the sewer plants value as proposed. The council requested additional information about earthquake insurance. The clerk will speak with Mike Whalen.

Committee Reports:

Property Cleanups:

President Richardson has received complaints about an alleyway needing mowing. Also a complaint from a private citizen about a neighbor driving through his property and making ruts. Councilman Wright will talk with the involved parties.

Special Projects: Councilman Redden has been in contact with Floyd County Clerk Linda Moeller about the cost of the special election. The location of the election center will need to be moved to John Jones Automotive, this is the new vote center for the Town of Greenville.

Ordinance 2013-TR-024: RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE DECREASE IN TOWN COUNCIL MEMBERSHIP (Setting up Election): Reading of the amended resolution was completed and the motion was made by President Richardson and seconded by Councilman Redden. Motion passed 3-1. Council members voting for the resolutions were President Richardson, Councilman Redden, and Councilwoman Hayes. Council member voting against the resolution was Councilman Wright.

Ordinance 2013-TR-035: RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE RESURFACING AND REPAIR OF GREENVILLE-GEORGETOWN ROAD WITHIN THE TOWN OF GREENVILLE, INDIANA: Reading of the resolution was completed and the motion was made by President Richardson and seconded by Councilman Redden. Motion passed 4-0.

Ordinance 2013-MR-037: RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE EXCHANGE AT NO COST OF THE 1996 MARSHAL'S DEPARTMENT JEEP VIN #1J4F42857TL302584 FOR A 2010 CROWN VIC POLICE INTERCEPTOR VIN # 2FABP7BV4AX109950 FROM THE FLOYD COUNTY SHERIFF DEPARTMENT AND THE COST OF PAINTING AND OTHER ITEMS NECESSARY TO MAKE IT COMPLIANT WITH THE GREENVILLE MARSHAL DEPARTMENT TWO EXISTING POLICE INTERCEPTORS OF THE GREENVILLE MARSHAL DEPARTMENT OF THE TOWN OF GREENVILLE, INDIANA: Reading of the resolution was completed and the motion was made by President Richardson and seconded by Councilman Redden. Motion passed 4-0.

Town Manager: Randal Johnes has posted his report on the town website along with emailing all council members and the clerk. No questions concerning the report.

Water Business:

Superintendent Getrost gave the monthly adjustment report. The council accepted the adjustments without comment. Superintendent Getrost gave an update about the ongoing projects. The Galena tank should be removed soon with an easement agreement that was granted thanks to the work of Town Manager Johnes, Final approval from Jacobi, Tombs and Lanz for the pumping station should be arriving soon.

A motion was made by President Richardson and seconded by Councilman Redden to approve a change order for funds being returned from a contractor for overcharges. Motion passed 4-0.

Sewer Plant:

Deputy Superintendent Schmidt gave his report for the sewage treatment plant. Steven has requested a credit card for purchases that will be for the Heritage Springs sewage treatment plant.

Ordinance 2013-WR-038: RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE ACQUIRING OF A CREDIT CARD BY THE GREENVILLE MUNICIPAL SEWER UTILITY: Reading of the resolution was completed and the motion was made by President Richardson and seconded by Councilman Redden. Motion passed 4-0.

Heritage Springs Developers, Thieneman Builders has requested an amendment to the standard operating procedures for the Greenville Sewer Utility to wave billing upon connection to the system. The request is that no bill will be sent until the home is sold to a new owner. The sewers are not being used until someone moves into the new address. Currently charges are occurring upon connection to the sewer lines. Water and sewer are being disconnected upon unpaid monthly billings. The council discussed this matter and voted 4-0 to put a moratorium on billing procedure to state no builder will be charged for sewer until the home is sold and previous paid billing to be refunded until a resolution is presented at the next monthly meeting.

Pastor Jason Sparks from Redeeming Vine Baptist Church was in attendance and reminded the council that his church will be holding a free medical clinic on July 27, 2013 from 10am to 2pm. Pastor Sparks also made the council aware of future plans to hold a possible festival next summer including a fireworks show.

No further business coming before the Council the meeting was adjourned.
