Terry Boaz opened the meeting. All members, Charles Birkla and two visitors were present. Claims were presented and approved for payment. The treasurer's report as of June 30, 1973 shows a total balance of \$9,781.68, (General Fund \$1,617.14; Street Fund \$4,639.33 and CCIF \$3,525.21). Our Revenue sharing fund has \$668.03.

It was agreed by all that the repair work on the tractor should be drawn from the water utility since much of the mowing is done at the lake.

Robert Gibson moved and Donald Uhl seconded that we permit Tri-County Water Company to serve a new housing development on Stiller Road. All voted in favor.

Donald Uhl moved and Robert Gibson seconded that we annex seven(7) lots that were a part of the Carl Hays farm and the quarry of all the property owners approve.

Charles Birkla reported that the alley to the park has been rocked. He is to see if Bud Ollis would grade some alleys.

Gary Jacobi reported our local road and street projects have been approved. We will accept bids at the next board meeting.

The board agreed to let the Methodist Church place a sign on the common grounds at U.S. 150 and Greenville Georgetown Road if it is situated so as not to interfere with traffic visibility.

Fred Owen complained of the alley to his property was impassable. The board agreed to clean litter from the alley so that it is passable.

Donald Uhl moved the meeting be closed.
