Minutes of the previous meeting were approved. Financial statements were presented to each board member.

V.J. Miller motioned for Gary Getrost to contact Cristiani Excavating to start work on new line for Pekin Road as soon as possible, the motion was seconded by Buck Spears.

The board approved payment of an additional sum of \$920.40, to Bartron Painting to absorb the loss incurred in the painting of the Greenville Water Tower. The motion was made by Mr. Spears, and seconded by Mr. Miller.

Mr. Richardson advised the board of new tires needed on the Police Car, Mr. Miller motioned and Mr. Spears seconded to have the new tires purchased.
