The regular monthly meeting of the Greenville Town Board, held this date, was called to order by President H. L. Spears. All Board members were present. Also in attendance: Max Mason, Janice Gibson, Gary Getrost, V. J. Miller, Talbotte Richardson, Vernon McKown, Elmo McKinney, Dave Nichols, Brenda Gitner, Julia Herron, Fred Muddiman, and Herman Miller.

The minutes for the August meeting were read and approved. Financial statements and claims were presented to the Board. The claims were approved and the financial statements accepted by the Board.

Gary Getrost told the Board he had inspected the Bickel Development and found it to be as Charles Bickel claimed. The Board agreed to sell Charles Bickel water meters at \$75.00 per meter.

Gary presented the Board quotes for fences around the two water towers. One was from "B" Hive fence Co. for \$2,149.32, and the other from New Albany Fence Co. for \$1756.00. Buck Spears made a motion to accept the quote from New Albany Fence Co. Ron Lamb seconded.

Vernon McKown informed the Board of his committee's effort to get a rural route from the Greenville Post Office. The Board voiced its support. Dave Nichols, Postmaster, said he is available for factual input only.

Julia Herron and Brenda Gitner complained about the water pressure on Pekin Road. Gary said he hadn't heard a complaint since installing the 4" main. The Board asked Gary to put a gauge on their line to check the pressure which must be 22 lbs. Also check the pressure on Brenda Gitners, Dave Nichols, and Herman Miller's lines. Vernon McKown said there was once a booster pump. Tri-County Water won't agree to a connection which could solve the problem.

Fred Muddiman of Floyds Knobs Water Co. is ^A in the proposed connection between Greenville Water Utility and Floyds Knobs Water Co. for emergency use only. He suggested the rate Greenville Water charges Floyds Knobs Water be the same as Floyds Knobs charges Greenville. The Board agreed and said "Lets go with it." Fred will tell his crew to start the connection.

V.J. Miller said Jimmy Zininger wants the Board to write to the Floyd Co. Board of Health about a sewerage problem at Roy Barbey's. Zininger has already called the Board of Health but they want a letter from the Town Board before they investigate. The Board asked Gary to call the Board of Health.

Elaine Miller reported the Floyd Co. Tax Board approved the Town budget for 1986.

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Gary received a request from Fred Grauel to install a water line in the right-of-way. Grauel is working for a construction firm and wants to put in the line with a jackhammer. Max Mason said he must have permission from the County and install the line to water utility specifications.

Joe Roudenbush will mow weeds in Town.

Gary reported a 9½% water loss this month.

Elmo McKinney said he came to speak for the people on Pekin Road and about the hearing on Revenue Sharing. Jack Sprigler said the Revenue Sharing money is to be used for streets.


The Board approved the transfer of \$15,000.00 from the operating fund to a 5 year CD for the Bond Interest Retirement Fund.
