

SEPTEMBER 24, 2003



Dear Mr. Getrost:


In response to the above request by Greenville Water Company, the Edwardsville Water Corporation Board of Directors has asked our engineering and accounting firms to submit a cost estimate for the project.

A legal contract would have to be prepared and we would apply for a thirty-day filing with the IURC. If Greenville Water Company would decide not to purchase the water according to the terms; Greenville Water Company would be responsible for paying the legal and engineering fees incurred.

The Edwardsville Water Corporation Board of Directors discussed having steps in water usage that would help save Greenville on their facility charge until they reach the amount set in the contract.
