The minutes for the September meeting were read. Jack Sprigler moved the minutes be approved as read. Ron Lamb seconded. Financial statements and claims were presented to the Board. The claims were approved and financial statements accepted by the Board.

Gary Getrost reported the water pressure on Pekin road was low. He is negotiating with Borden-Tri County for a connection with their line to improve the pressure.

Talbotte Richardson reported Mrs. Alvis Perkins is working on having Donnie Perkins clean up his lot.

Representatives of Harrison County Bank brought plans for their building.

New Albany Fence Company has the material for fences around the water towers.

The Board approved sending out specifications on a truck for sealed bids to be returned no later than November 15.

The Board approved transferring \$5000.00 from a CD to the Local Roads & Streets Fund.

Effective January 1, 1985 the Town charges the utility \$250.00 per month rent.

The Board stated that a tap in fee is \$350.00 plus a \$25.00 meter deposit.

The Board reviewed the formal Personnel Policy that was approved January 1, 1982. A descrepancy regarding leave status during 1984 for Janice Gibson and V.J. Miller was discovered. The Board approved back pay for these individuals since it is the intent of the Board to adhere to policy. Back pay in the amount of \$587.50 for Janice Gibson and \$159.93 for V.J. Miller was approved by the Board.

The Board also accepted the bid of Libs Paving in the amount of \$9065.00 for paving streets. (Attached).

Vacation of alley between lots 79,80,81,82, and 111, 112, 113, 114 was approved. No opposition was made in vacating the alley.
