**Minutes of Greenville Town Council Public Hearing on the Annexation
of Heritage Springs Sub-Division
October 19th, 2009**

President Talbotte Richardson called the Public Hearing to order. Other Councilpersons present were Councilwoman Patti Hayes, Councilman Jim Pearce Jr., Councilman Bob Wright, and Councilman Randal Johnes along with Greenville Town Attorney Rick Fox. No property owners or residents within the Heritage Springs Sub-Division Area to be annexed were present. Councilman Randal Johnes recorded minutes of the Public Hearing due to the absence of Clerk Jack Travillian.

President Richardson opened the Public Hearing at 7:00 PM stating that this meeting was being held to allow those within the Heritage Springs Sub-Division to address their questions and concerns related to the annexation.

President Richardson stated he would wait 15 minutes before adjourning the meeting to allow any property owners or residents of Heritage Springs Sub-Division Area the opportunity to speak if they were running late for the Public Hearing.

Councilman Johnes addressed the remaining milestones to be completed in accordance with the Target Schedule for Implementing the Voluntary Annexation of Heritage Springs Sub-Division by the Town of Greenville, Indiana starting with November 24th, 2009 through April 14th, 2013. See chart attached.


**TARGET SCHEDULE FOR IMPLEMENTING THE VOLUNTARY
ANNEXATION
OF HERITAGE SPRINGS SUBDIVISION BY THE TOWN OF
GREENVILLE, INDIANA**

Monday, May 11, 2009	Petition for voluntary annexation filed by more than 51% of the owners or 75% of the assessed value of Heritage Springs Subdivision pursuant to IC 36-4-3-5 (42% contiguous)
Monday, July 13, 2009	(1) Pass Resolution adopting Fiscal Plan at Town Council meeting, and (2) introduce Annexation Ordinance (pass on first reading)
Sunday, July 26, 2009	Complete mailing of notices to all owners in the annexed area by certified mail and publish notice of public hearing in <i>The Tribune</i>
Tuesday, October 13, 2009	Council conducts public hearing on proposed annexation ordinance (78 th day since last date of notice and publication)
Tuesday, November 24, 2009	Adopt Annexation Ordinance (42 nd day since public hearing; last day to legally adopt [Day 60 since hearing] Tuesday, October 13 th , 2009)
Wednesday, November 25, 2009	Send written notice to fire district of adoption of ordinance (no effect on fire service)
Wednesday, November 25, 2009	Deliver notice of adoption of Annexation Ordinance to <i>The Tribune</i>
Monday, November 30, 2009	Annexation ordinance published and posted (starts 90-day remonstrance period)
Friday, January 29, 2010	60 th day since publication – Contiguity appeal period expires
Tuesday, March 2, 2010	92 nd day since publication – Remonstrance period expires
Wednesday, March 10, 2010	Certified copy of Ordinance recorded in Floyd County Recorder office
Wednesday, March 10, 2010	Certified copy of Ordinance filed with Secretary of State, Circuit Court Clerk, County Board of Voter Registration, County Auditor, Office of Census Data
Wednesday, March 10, 2010	Secretary of State notified of effective date of annexation
Wednesday, April 14, 2010	Annexation effective date (per IC 36-4-3-12(b))
April 14, 2011	Last day to begin providing non-capital services
April 14, 2013	Last day to begin providing capital services


With no Property Owners or Residents coming before the Council the meeting was adjourned at 7:15 PM.
