Terry Boaz opened the meeting. All members of the board, all members of the 1976 board, James Harl, Robert Tilly, Janice Gibson, Ernest Purvis and a few visitors were present. Claims were presented and approved for payment. The checking fund has a balance of October 31, 1975 of \$7,305.67. (General \$2,408.91, Local Road \$657.90, Street \$3,714.85 and CCIF \$3,524.01.) The Revenue Sharing fund has a balance of \$2,922.15.

Ernest Purvis reported that fluoride is now being added to the water as approved by the State Board of Health. He stated that the level of water has raised some with the recent rains.

Robert Gibson stated that Midwest Engineers have not completed our water supply report, but that it should be done by the next meeting.

Bill Neal requested a 3 inch water meter when additional customers can be added with the approval of the State Board of Health.

Lee Miller reported that after the pressure was turned up on the John Pectol Road that the pressure was good in his subdivison. It was also reported to the water company by the property owners in the subdivison and also on the Evan's Jacobi Road that the water pressure in their homes was much better.

Gary Jacobi stated that the State Board of Tax Commissioners approved a 54¢ property tax levy for the town to be collected in 1976.

Mildred Bierman asked that a water meter be relocated on her property closer to her home.

James Harl reported that he had been looking for a town marshall office. Mr. Andy Van Winkle would provide a rent free room above the Greenville Market. Other possiblities were discussed. Jim will report back to the board.

Robert Gibson moved the meeting be closed.
