MINUTES OF TOWN COUNCIL REGULAR MEETING

The monthly meeting of the Greenville Town Council was called to order by President Ron Lamb. Attending were Councilmembers Hall and Williams and Clerk Treasurer Jack Sprigler. Also in attendance was Janice Gibson, Gary Getrost, Talbott Richardson, Paul Buche, Billy Burkhart and Bob Isgrigg.

The Council approved the minutes of the October meeting and claims presented to the Council for the Town and Utility.

The Clerk-Treasurers' Report of Financial Condition indicates bank balances for the Town and Utility appear to be correct.

The Council adopted Ordinance No. 1989-03, an Ordinance Vacating a Public Alley, there being no objection, written or oral.

The Council accepted the resignation of the Deputy Marshall, Paul Buche, effective on or about June 1, 1990.

Ron Lamb instructed Gary Getrost to contact the County Highway Department for assistance in clearing Parkland Heights Subd. in the event of snow. Gary stated he has been in contact with the same individual as last year for snow removal within the town and that he would contact the county for their help as in the past.


Bob Isgrigg informed the Council he submitted information to the State for consideration under the Focus Awards Program, using criteria for a sewer system, in determining overall assessment.

Talbott Richardson stated there will be a need for an additional deputy to train until Paul Buche leaves. The Council advised him the impact of insurance costs and salary for such person but the Council would check with the carrier to determine additional costs, but the Clerk Treasurer stated there are no funds available in 1989 or 1990 for salary.


Gary Getrost requested Council approval allowing Brent Boyd to take home the Chevrolet Pick up Truck which the Council approved but not for personal use.

This letter is a six month notice.


In the time before then I intend to complete the following projects.
