Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved. Financial Statements for the month of November ~~was~~ presented to each board member.

Claims were presented for payment and approved.


Kevin Reed of River Hills Regional Planning approached the board with a resolution concerning Technical Planning Assistance. After discussion the board approved the resolution.

Ms. LuAnne Shields complained to the board concerning Zirn Industries who is now located at the old Trus-Con Property. Ms. Shields was advised the board would check out her complaint and advise her of the boards' decision.

Robert Isgrigg of Environmental Consultants, reported to the board on the lake retirement possibilities. Mr. Isgrigg informed the board the cost of upgrading the lake would be approximately \$81,000 or .52 per 1,000 gals. Other cost factors were presented regarding current cost per current usage for retiring ~~boards~~ and existing plant facilities and cost of producing water as of now.

Being no further business before the board, Mr. Gibson motioned for adjournment, seconded by Bill Voyles.

LEGISLATION PROVIDING FOR THE DELIVERY OF TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE
TO LOCAL UNITS OF GOVERNMENT AND FOR THE ALLOWANCE OF
CONTRACTUAL ARRANGEMENTS BETWEEN LOCAL UNITS OF GOVERNMENT
AND REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSIONS

WHEREAS, regional and multi-county planning agencies have been formed throughout the State of Indiana to plan comprehensively for future development and to promote orderly development; and,

WHEREAS, the River Hills Regional Planning Commission has been formed by concurrent resolution or interlocal agreement of the local governments of Floyd Co., Clark Co., Washington Co., Scott Co., Harrison Co.; and,


WHEREAS, the Greenville Town Board of Trustees has established that there exists a great and growing need for technical assistance to local units of government for planning, developing, administering, improving and securing public and private grants-in-aid, intergovernmental cooperative arrangements, and performance of functions, duties and responsibilities; and,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Greenville Town Board of Trustees hereby endorses and encourages the adoption of legislation providing that Regional Planning Commissions may provide technical assistance upon request of any local unit of government in its region and that Regional Commissions and their local units of governments may enter contractual arrangements for technical assistance.

PROVISION OF SIGNIFICANT FUNDING THROUGH THE TECHNICAL
PLANNING ASSISTANCE TO LOCAL UNITS OF GOVERNMENT FUND

WHEREAS, existing multi-county and regional commissions are presently providing valuable assistance to local units of government in Indiana; and,

WHEREAS, there exists a continuing and increasing need for assistance which is being provided by regional and multi-county agencies; and

WHEREAS, local units of government in Indiana are presently and have in the past provided financial resources for the operation of regional and multi-county agencies; and,

WHEREAS, most units of local government are extremely limited in the amount of financial assistance they are able to provide for the operation of regional and multi-county agencies; and,

WHEREAS, State agencies of Indiana have requested the assistance of multi-county or regional agencies while providing limited or no financial assistance; and,

WHEREAS, there exists a need for additional financial assistance for multi-county and regional agencies in order to cover costs of services provided by said agencies to state agencies; and,

WHEREAS, there exists a need for financial assistance which would allow multi-county and regional agencies the flexibility to respond to various requests of state or local agencies; and,


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Greenville Town Board of Trustees hereby endorses and encourages the provision of significant state financial assistance through the "Technical Planning Assistance to Local Units of Government Fund" as provided by I.C. 18-7-1.5.
