An executive meeting was held between President Robert Gibson, Jack Sprigler President elect and Virginia Ham, Town Marshall concerning a problem with the Floyd County Police and the Marshall.

Ms. Ham stated the sheriffs' office told her to work a disturbance on the Kiesler Road and while at this location was advised by radio to work an accident at the Western Truck Stop.


Mr. Gibson stated the County Police told him that she was told to work the Kiesler Road incident and when she approached the location a deputy stated she was using profane language when she arrived.

Ms. Ham stated she did not use any such language. She also stated that the deputy told her to stay with the incident on Kiesler Road and she did so and then went home. While at home she heard on the radio that she was needed at the Western Truck Stop for an accident.

Mr. Gibson advised Ms. Ham that the police car cannot be used outside the town limits of Greenville and that he asked the new board to contact Sheriff Schindler to come out and advise the board of an understanding we should have with the Floyd County Police.

Mr. Gibson stated he has received complaints from Floyd County Police concerning alcoholic beverages being purchased in Georgetown and brought into Greenville and that those doing so stated they were doing it for the Town Marshall. Ms. Ham denied this fact.

Mr. Sprigler advised Ms. Ham to keep a log of all activities as Marshall immediately.
