ORDINANCE CONCERNING CHARGES FOR EXCESSIVE SERVICE RUNS AND N.S.F. POLICY FOR THE GREENVILLE WATER UTILITY GREENVILLE, INDIANA

WHEREAS, the Greenville Water Utility Council of the Town of Greenville, Indiana, in the interest of controlling cost of operating expenses, has deemed it necessary that the Greenville Water Utility Council develop an Ordinance Policy which defines rules and charges for excessive service runs per customer's request serviced by the Greenville Water Utility and N.S.F. checks received from Greenville Water Utility customers;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GREENVILLE WATER UTILITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GREENVILLE, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. This Ordinance pertains to excessive service runs for the following per customer's request:
 - > Re-reads of water meter
 - > Inspection of water meter
 - > Water leak inspection
 - > Water service shut-off
 - > Water service turn-on
- 2. A charge of Thirty-Five and No Cents U.S. Dollars {\$35.00} shall apply on a case by case basis for excessive requests. An excessive request shall be considered more than two service runs in a twelve month period. However in given certain circumstances the Greenville Water Utility Superintendent is authorized to wave the charges at his/her discretion.

- 3. Non Sufficient Fund Check:
 - ➤ If a Greenville Water Utility Customer pays their account to prevent water service disconnection with a check that is returned because of N.S.F., it shall be considered as non-payment of account and water service shall be disconnected and a reconnection fee and payment in full of their account shall be paid in full before water service can be reconnected.
 - ➤ If the water service disconnection was created by a water leak that has caused an unusually higher charge, a repayment agreement may be proposed by the Greenville Water Utility Superintendent to the Greenville Water Utility Council for approval to prevent service disconnection.
- 4. The Town of Greenville Clerk Treasurer shall publish this Ordinance within 30 days in the New Albany Tribune after passage.
- 5. The Town of Greenville Clerk Treasurer shall attach a copy of the publication and related information to the original signed Ordinance and a PDF file shall be added to the electronic file copy of this Ordinance.
- 6. The Town of Greenville Clerk Treasurer shall have this Ordinance recorded with the appropriate State of Indiana Regulatory Agencies.
