

**Minutes of Greenville Special Meeting
February 09th, 2015**

Council President David Moore called the special meeting to order. Other Councilpersons present were Daryl Kepley, John Braham, and Greg Redden, along with Clerk Travillian.

Meeting was opened with a discussion about Marshal's Department. President Moore was requesting to put Councilman Braham in charge of dispersing the funds for the Marshal's Department. Clerk Travillian advised that by state statute this would not be allowed, all expenditures must be approved by full council unless an emergency appropriation is required.

The council has received a complaint about members serving on the Marshal's Department; the complainant felt this was a conflict of interest. When conferred with the State the council was advised that as long as it is not a paid position there is no conflict. Supplies and tools (phone & car) for the job are not considered compensation. President Moore advised he will voluntarily not vote on any funding for the Marshal's Department in order to avoid the appearance of a conflict of interest. President Moore noted that all complaints from this point forward must be in written form, in order to be followed up properly.

Town clean up – there has been additional complaints about the condition of some properties and Councilman Braham will be following up.


